*The Australian Screen Production Incentive provides tax incentives for film, television and other screen production in Australia.*

- The **producer offset** entitles production companies to a 40 per cent rebate on eligible feature films and 30 per cent on other eligible formats for productions with significant Australian content.
- The **location offset** is a 30 per cent rebate for the production of large-budget film and television projects shot in Australia, starting principal photography on or after 1 July 2023.
- The **post, digital and visual effects (PDV) offset** is a 30 per cent rebate that supports work on post, digital and visual effects production (PDV) in Australia, regardless of where a project is shot.

*The **digital games tax offset (DGTO)** is a refundable tax offset which allows eligible companies that develop digital games in Australia to claim 30% of their total qualifying Australian development expenditure.*
